Course Overview

This course aims to study some cinematographic productions based on literary texts by renowned writers of the so-called Latin American boom.

The course is based on the analysis and discussion of the main characteristics of the culture, values and themes of the Latin American reality present in these literary and cinematographic samples.

This is an elective course, it is taught in Spanish and answers the question; *How can a second language student of Spanish increase their sociocultural knowledge of Latin America by reading literary texts from the Latin American boom and their film adaptations?*
