Course Overview

The participants of this course should be able to function naturally, with little effort in different cultural interactions, as they are expected to have sufficient linguistic resources that allow them to communicate fluently and spontaneously in situations with a certain degree of complexity or with external interference.

In addition, students will be able to recognize the denotative and connotative meaning of dialectal Spanish expressions, and give an opinion on criteria such as: religion, politics, art and history, as well as particular aspects of each culture of our Latin American countries.
